



What inspired you specifically about legal to have a project there?
 "Legal and most surrounding countries experience a lot of gender oppression. I was looking for an organization that was empowering women and girls through education, specifically a local government organization which I could be very involved in, supported by our country. I wanted to really be immersed and a part of the solution. Nepal has a very high trafficking rate in tourism hubs. When I visited Nepal, I fell in love with the country and the people. All the children I met became like my own and I really felt that I had the ability to be a woman with a vision therefore I want to become their voice for the rest of the world...that is my purpose."

How does your husband maintain itself in your day-to-day life?
 "I'm doing this new thing where the support is my main as when I receive myself everything by just being very clear and when I should be saying someone. It's just like that we are more push and I'm going to break it."

Are there specific challenges to being a female in the fashion industry?
 "Not really in the fashion, or I'm sure there are but I can only talk from my experience and I haven't really experienced anything. I do like to work with all different types of people that might have something to do with it."

Can we talk about Instagram? You have quite a following. How do you think you have the strength of it in a woman? And the concept?
 "I actually think it's a great platform for me to be able to share and educate my followers about gender equality and the importance of educating girls. I love my fans and followers so much, they always write to me, telling me how much they inspired them and that is unbelievably humbling. Knowing that the message I'm giving is not being understood, but that they are to believe in themselves and have confidence in their future is equally as important as me as supporting a girl in Nepal...to another girl in female empowerment. I would want girls to know that their idea for anything they want to do is to be but it all comes with a risk and with all that."

If you could inspire one change in others what would it be?
 "Oh yes, yes! That's hard! How about more compassion and empathy...if everyone could have more compassion and empathy for one another the world would be a better place. People spend too much time thinking about themselves and themselves and their own success with others in any way to ask "how are you?" and only focus on the success."
